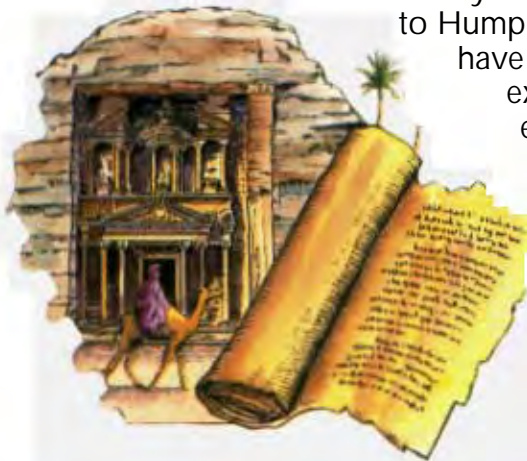

King Tut's Treasures 9 days/ 8 nights

Day 1-2 DEPART

JFK-CAIRO. Arrive Cairo where an HLO representative assists you through formalities and to your hotel.

Day 3 CAIRO. Start with a guided tour of the Egyptian Museum, home to King Tut's vast treasures. Proceed to medieval Old Cairo, Saladin's Citadel Fortress and the magnificent Alabaster Mosque. Later in the day, explore the 1000-year old Khan El Khalili Bazaar, 500 shops brimming with exotic goods. **BB, D**

Day 4 CAIRO. Start with a tour of the awesome Great Pyramids and Sphinx. After lunch, travel to Sakkara and see the Step Pyramid, history's first stone building, then to Memphis, ancient capital of Egypt. **CB, L, D**

Day 5 CAIRO-LUXOR. Fly to Luxor (ancient Thebes), where you will explore the Valley of the Kings and tour King Tut's tomb. Then drive to

the Valley of the Queens, Hatshepsut's temple and the Colossi of Memnon. **CB, D**

Day 6 LUXOR. You will visit the Temple of Luxor and Karnak Temple, the largest religious complex ever built by man. The afternoon and evening are free. **BB, D**

Day 7 EDFU ASWAN. Visit the Temple of Horus at Edfu, then proceed to Aswan, where you will visit the Botanical island and Aga Khan mausoleum. **BB, D**

Day 8 ASWAN-CAIRO. Spend a free morning exploring Aswan, then fly back to Cairo. After checking in, enjoy your last evening in Egypt. **BB, D**

Day 9 DEPART CAIRO. Depart for home with a lifetime of memories from Egypt.

Gift of the Nile 12 days/11 nights

Day 1-2 DEPART JFK-CAIRO. Upon arrival in Cairo, an HLO representative will assist you through formalities, then to your hotel for check-in, special welcome.

Day 3 CAIRO. Your Egyptian adventure begins with a tour of the awesome Great Pyramids and Sphinx. You can even ride a camel! After lunch at the historic Mena House Hotel, travel to Sakkara and see the Step Pyramid, history's first stone building, then to Memphis, ancient capital of Egypt. **BB,L,D**

Day 4 CAIRO. Start with a guided tour of the Egyptian Museum, home to King Tut's treasures. Then proceed to medieval Old Cairo, Saladin's Citadel Fortress and the magnificent

Alabaster Mosque. Later in the day, explore the exciting Khan El Khalili Bazaar. **CB,D**

Day 5 CAIRO-LUXOR. Fly to Luxor and transfer to your Nile Cruise boat to check-in and have lunch. Afterwards, explore the Temple of Luxor and Karnak Temple, the largest religious complex ever built by man. **BB, L, D**

Day 6 LUXOR. Travel by motorcoach to Abydos, spiritual capital of ancient Egypt, and then onto the Greco-Roman era Temple at Denderah. Later, swim in the ship's pool or relax on the shaded afterdeck. **B, L, D**

Day 7 LUXOR-EDFU. Visit the Valley of the Kings and King Tut's tomb, then on to the Valley of the Queens, Hatshepsut's temple and Colossi of Memnon. You will then sail to Edfu and visit the Temple of Horus. **B,L,D**

Day 8 EDFU-ASWAN. Sail to Kom Ombo, where you visit a Ptolemaic temple after breakfast, then proceed to Aswan, where a picturesque felucca will take you to visit the Botanical Island and Aga Khan mausoleum. **B, L, D**

Day 9 ASWAN-ABU SIMBEL-CAIRO. After visiting the spectacular High Dam, you will board a plane to Abu Simbel and see one of man's greatest modern engineering feats, the relocated Temple of Ramses Ramses II. Later that day you will return to Cairo. **B, L, D**

Day 10 CAIRO-ALEXANDRIA. This morning, drive to Alexandria by air conditioned motor coach to see the Mediterranean city of Alexandria, built by Alexander the Great and capital of Egypt under Cleopatra. **CB, D**

Day 11 CAIRO. Your final day is free to relax, shop or visit an Egyptian farm family for lunch. That evening you will experience the memorable Sound and Light Show at the Great Pyramids. **BB, D**

Day 12 DEPART CAIRO. You will be transferred to the airport for your flight home.

received the Ten Commandments. Then tour St. Catherine's monastery, site of the Biblical burning bush. Drive to the Egyptian-Israeli border town of Taba, then follow the Dead Sea road to Masada, the Qum-ran Caves, Bethany and the Good Samaritan inn. Overnight in Jerusalem. **BB, D**

Day 7 JERUSALEM. Start at the Mount of Olives, then visit the Chapel of the Ascension, Garden of Gethsemane and Church of All Nations. Ride through the Kedron Valley to see Hezekiah's

Tunnel, the Pool of Siloam and the Church of St. Peter. In Bethlehem, tour Shepherd's Field, Church of Nativity and St. Jerome's Grotto, before returning to Jerusalem. **BB, D**

Day 8 JERUSALEM. A walking tour of the Old City includes Temple Mount, Dome of the Rock and the Wailing Wall. Proceed to Stephen's Gate, Pilate's Judgement Hall, Church of the Holy Sepulchre and more. **BB, D**

Egypt and the Holy Land 12 days/ 11 nights

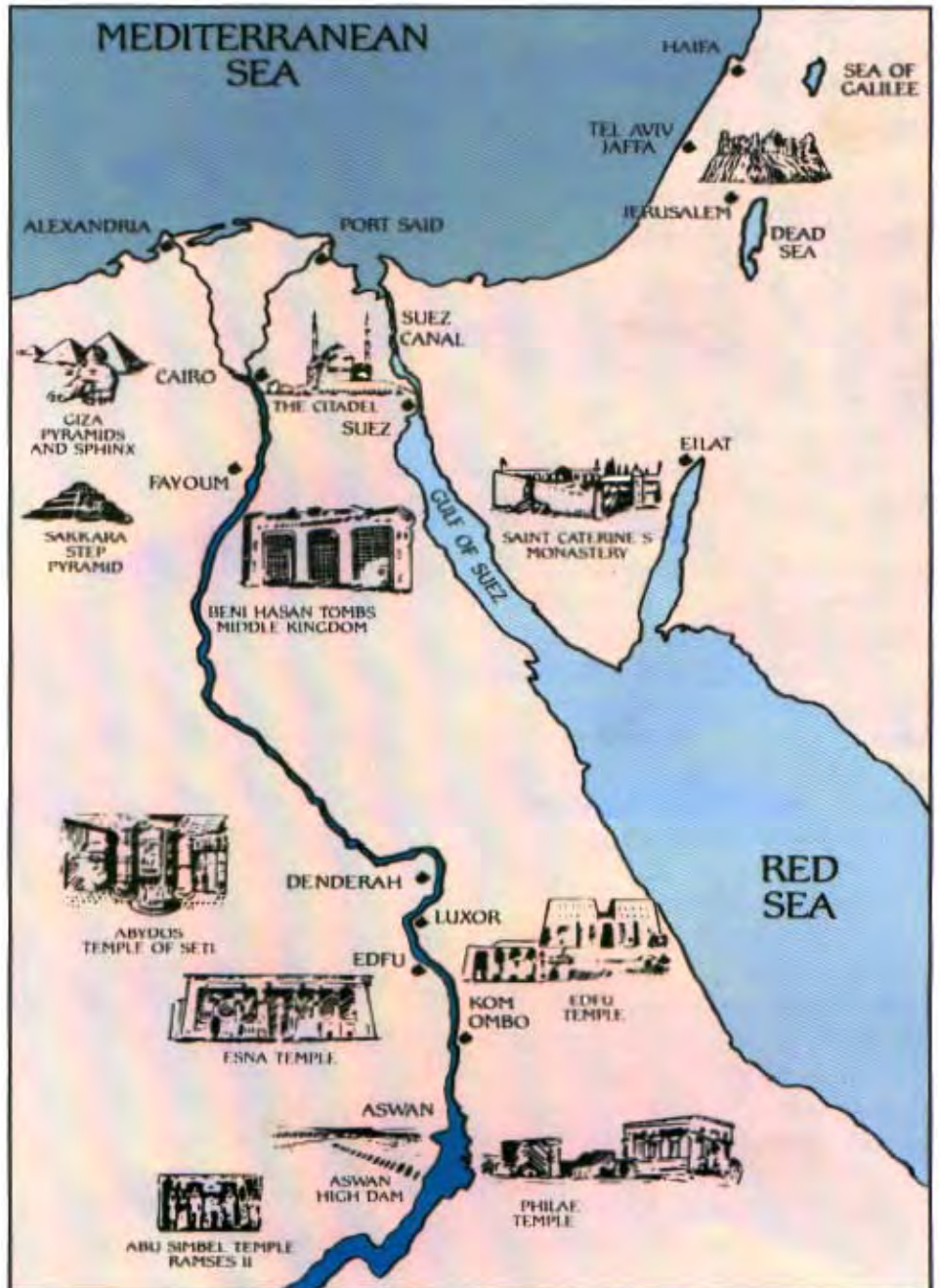
Day 1-2 DEPART JFK-CAIRO. Arrive in Cairo, check into your hotel.

Day 3 CAIRO. Visit the Egyptian Museum, then stroll through Old Cairo to visit a 1000-year old Christian church and Ben Ezra synagogue. Citadel Fortress & mosque, then on to the Khan el Khalili to experience Egyptian shopping. **BB,L,D.**

Day 4 CAIRO. Drive to the Step Pyramid at Sakkara, then visit Egypt's ancient capital city of Memphis. After lunch at the historic Mena House hotel, you will experience the Great Pyramids and legendary Sphinx. **BB, L**

Day 5 CAIRO-ST. CATHERINE'S. Trace the path of Moses as you proceed by air conditioned motor coach (or car) from Cairo, cross the Suez Canal, and across the Sinai desert. Stop for lunch and wade in the water where Moses parted the Red Sea. Check into your hotel. **BB, L, D**

Day 6 ST. CATHERINE'S-JERUSALEM. Climb Mt. Sinai for a spectacular sunrise where Moses





and Mount of Temptation, then to Nazareth, Church of Annunciation, Carpentry Shop and Mary's Well. **BB, D**

**Day 11
TIBERIAS-TEL**

AVIV. A boat will transport you across the Sea of Galilee to Capernum, the Mount of Beatitudes and the River Jordan. Then travel by motor coach to Meggido, the Valley of Jezreel and Haifa.

Finish the day at your hotel in Tel Aviv. **BB, D**

Day 9 JERUSALEM. Travel to Mt. Zion, King David's Tomb, the Upper Room and Ein Karem, then enjoy a free afternoon in Jerusalem. **BB, D**

Day 10 JERUSALEM-TIBERIAS. Drive to Jericho, Elisha's Spring

Day 12 DEPART ISRAEL. Transfer to Ben Gurion airport for your departure home or on to Jordan. **CB**

River Jordan Tour
5 days/4 nights**

Day 12 TEL AVIV-AMMAN. Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for your departure to Amman Jordan. An HLO representative will meet you upon arrival at Queen Alia International Airport. assist you through formalities and transfer you by private car to your hotel. **BB**

Day 13 AMMAN. After breakfast, your tour of the "White City" of Amman begins. The morning will be spent visiting sites from ancient Roman times to modern day, including museums, the Citadel, amphitheater and souks. After lunch, you will be driven to Jerash, the best preserved example of ancient Roman civilization. Then drive on to the 12th century Saracen castle at Ajlun before returning to your hotel. **B, L**

Day 14 AMMAN -PETRA. Depart in the morning to Petra. En route, visit Madaba, site of St. George's Cathedral. Next, you'll see Mt. Nebo, thought to be the burial site of Moses. Then it is onto the 12th century Crusader hilltop fortress at Kerak. Finally, check into your hotel at Petra for the night. **B, L, D**

Day 15 PETRA. Petra was once the ancient Nabatean capital, carved from a mountainside out in the desert. Your full-day tour includes a guided tour on horseback of what has become known as "The Lost City." **B, L, D**

Day 16 PETRA-DEPART TO USA. After breakfast, transfer to Queen Alia International Airport via the desert highway for your return flight to the USA. **B**

**Red Sea Dive Tour
10 days/9 nights**

Day 1-2 DEPART JFK-CAIRO. After your overnight flight, an HLO representative will greet you, assist you through formalities and transfer you to your 5-star hotel.

Day 3 CAIRO-SHARM EL SHEIKH. After breakfast, you will be transferred back to the airport for your flight to Sharm El Sheikh. Upon arrival, you will be greeted and driven to your hotel on the majestic Red Sea. **BB**

Day 4 SHARM EL SHEIKH. Today is the first of four full days diving the crystal clear, warm waters of the historic Red Sea. After breakfast, you will be taken by boat to your floating hotel, where experienced, knowledgeable dive masters will show you diving at its best. **BB**

Day 5 SHARM EL SHEIKH. Today you will take in more of the breathtaking dive sites, including Ras Mohamad, Jack Fish Alley, Jackson Reef, Sharks Bay and the Canyon, to name a few. Every day you receive filled air tanks, a weight belt and the services of your professional dive master. When you are not diving, take in area sights and activities with friends or simply enjoy the vibrant, natural beauty of the desert. **BB**

Day 6 SHARM EL SHEIKH. Explore more of the vibrant waters, coral valleys and steep canyon walls of the Red Sea, swimming with exotic species of fish and rare plant life. **BB**

Day 7 SHARM EL SHEIKH. Make the most of your final day at the Old World's most popular diving destination. **BB**

Day 8 SHARM EL SHEIKH-CAIRO.

After your last breakfast over looking the majestic Red Sea, transfer back to the airport for your return flight to Cairo. There, you will be met by an HLO representative and taken to your hotel. **BB**

Day 9 CAIRO. A full day of touring begins at the Egyptian Museum, where you can see first hand the treasures of King Tut. Day 1-2 DEPART JFK-ISTANBUL.

Day 5 ISTANBUL. Enjoy a free morning to shop and explore. Then after lunch, visit the Suleymaniye Mosque, Islamic Art Museum and Chora Church. Dinner at a local restaurant will finish out the day's activities. **B, D**

Day 6 ISTANBUL-IZMIR. In the morning you will fly to Izmir and check in at your hotel. Then you will attend an orientation session and half-day sightseeing tour of the city and surrounding area. **B, D**

Day 7 EPHEBUS-MARMARIS.

After checking out, you will drive to the historic ruins and after lunch, see the museum of Ephesus. After enjoying lunch, you will continue on to the coastal city of Marmaris and check into your hotel. **B, L, D**

Day 8 MARMARIS.

A morning tour of Marmaris will end at the country's largest yacht marina. After lunch, you will go on a yacht cruise along the sun-drenched bays and coves of Marmaris. **B, D**

Day 9 MARMARIS

CAUNOS. Enjoy a sight seeing tour of the rustic Dalyan River area. After lunch by the Dalyan River, you will visit the historic sites of Caunos.

B, L, D

Day 10 MARNARIS-RHODES.

After breakfast, you will drive to the harbor to board the ferry to Rhodes in the Greek Isles. After lunch and a tour of the island, you will return to Marmaris and your hotel by evening.

Day 11 MARNARIS-PAMUKKALE.

Visit the ancient spa town of Hierapolis, with its cotton white terraces. Take time for a swim in the warm spring waters. **B, L, D**

Day 12 ISTANBUL-USA. Fly from the Dalaman Airport back to Istanbul, to catch your return flight home.

Imperial Morocco Cities 9 days/8 nights

Day 1-2 DEPART JFK-CASABLANCA.

An HLO representative will greet you upon arrival at Casablanca International Airport and transfer you to your hotel for dinner and the night. **D**

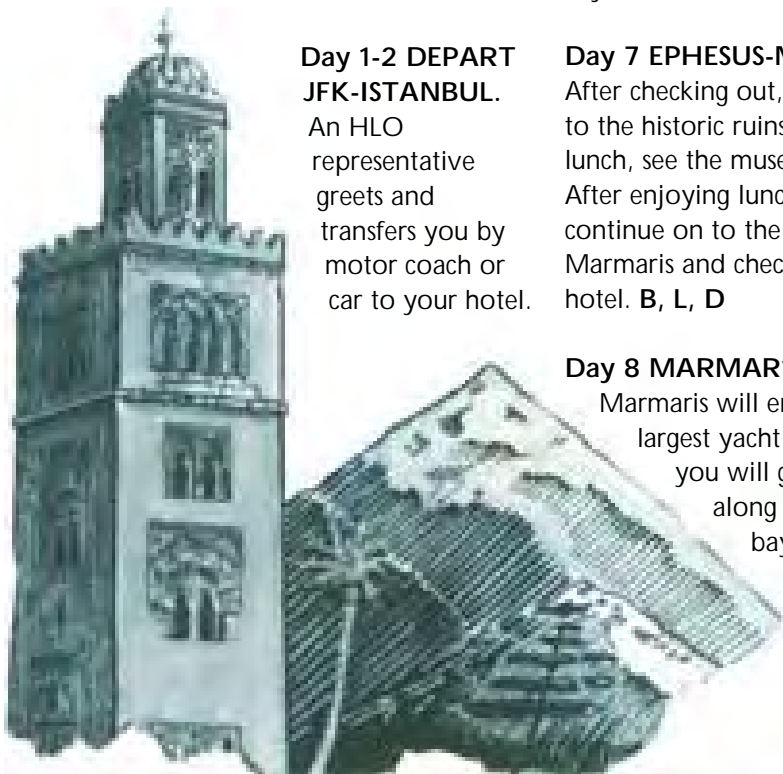
Day 3 CASABLANCA-RABAT.

After breakfast, you will tour the modern city of Casablanca to see the United Nation Square, Anfa residential quarter, the Mohkama -(Low Court) and the Great Mosque. After lunch, drive to Rabat, capital of Morocco, to visit the Royal Palace, Hassan Tower, Mohammed V Mausoleum and Roman ruins of Chellah. **B, L, D**

Day 4 RABAT-MEKNES-FES.

Arrive at provincial Meknes to see Bab Mansour and the Tomb of Moulay Ismail. After lunch, visit the Roman ruins of Volubilis, then to Fes for dinner and overnight. **B, L, D**

Day 5 FES. Here in the best preserved medieval moslem city,



you will visit Bouanania and Attarine Medersas, Moulay Idriss quarter, the famous fountain of Nejjarine and the Karaouine University. Your day includes a typical Moroccan lunch at the Old Palace in the Medina.

B, L, D

Day 6 FES-MARRAKESH. Depart in the morning to Beni-Mellal via Ifrane, a famous ski resort, and Azrou. Tour Beni-Mellal, in the orange growing region and enjoy lunch before proceeding to magical Marrakesh. **B, L, D**

Day 7 MARRAKESH. An all-day Marrakesh tour includes stops at Koutoubia, Bahia and Badia palaces, Saadian Tombs, souks and the famous Djemaa El Fna Square. Enjoy dinner at the Chez Ali Restaurant. **B, L, D**

Day 8 MARRAKESH-CASA BLANCA. After a leisure morning, depart for your return to Casa blanca and a last enchanted evening in Morocco. **B, L, D**

Day 9 CASABLANCA-DEPART USA. Have breakfast before transferring to the airport. **B**

EXTENSION: Saharan South Tour 8 days/7 nights

Tour the Sahara Desert by Land Rover, visiting exotic backwater towns by day and camping under the stars at night. **B, L, D**

East African Safari Adventure 16 days/ 15 nights

Day 1-2 DEPART JFK-CAIRO. Arrive Cairo for a one-day layover. An HLO representative will assist you through formalities for your transfer to the hotel.

Day 3 CAIRO. Use this day of leisure to relax, shop, or take an optional tour to the Great Pyramids and Sphinx, Egyptian Museum, Old Cairo or Memphis Sakkara. After an evening on your own, you will be transferred back to the airport for your late-night flight to Nairobi. **CB**

Day 4 NAIROBI- THE ARK. Arrive Nairobi where you will be met and assisted through customs. Board safari vans for the drive to Aberdare Country Club. After lunch, a bus takes you to The Ark, a game lodge overlooking a waterhole. Spend an afternoon and evening on the terrace to watch the pageant of life unfold. **L, D**

Day 5 THE ARK-NAIROBI. Enjoy the Kenyan countryside on your drive to Nairobi, with stops at the Equator and native villages. Spend the afternoon at leisure after checking into the renowned Norfolk Hotel or similar. **B**

Day 6 NAIROBI-AMBOSELI. Drive from Nairobi to Amboseli National Park. Check into a picturesque resort lodge with a stunning view of Mt. Kilimanjaro. **B,D**



Day 7 AMBOSELI. Early morning game drives are your best bet for viewing the 'big five' — elephant, buffalo, rhino, lion and cheetah. Enjoy lunch at the lodge and an afternoon game drive. **B, L, D**

Day 8 AMBOSELI-SERENGETI. After a short drive to Namanga at the Kenyan/ Tanzanian border, you will travel to Arusha, Africa's key Tanzanite market. Then proceed to the Serengeti Plain and your lodge. Experience an afternoon game drive before dinner. **B, L, D**

Day 9 SERENGETI. Explore the seemingly endless Serengeti plains viewing dramatic scenery and countless animals. You will have a morning and afternoon game drive. **B, L, D**

Day 10 SERENGETI. Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives through the world's largest national park, or relax by the pool. **B, L, D**

Day 11 SERENGETI-NGORONGORO. After breakfast view game as you once again cross the vast Serengeti plains on your drive to awesome Ngorongoro Crater. On the way, visit Olduvai Gorge,

site of the world's oldest humans. Check into the luxurious lodge with a breathtaking view of the crater floor, far below. **B, L, D**

Day 12 NGORONGORO. Descend into the morning mists to the floor of the ten-mile wide, 2,500-foot deep crater, for game viewing at its best in the world's largest natural zoo!

B, L, D

Day 13 NGORONGORO-NAIROBI. Never tire of viewing game on your drive back to Nairobi's Norfolk Hotel. Enjoy many interesting stops along the way or opt to fly back. **B**

Day 14 NAIROBI. Take your choice of optional tours around bustling

Nairobi, Karen Blixen's home and the Rothschild Giraffe Centre, or enjoy a day of shopping around town or leisure around the pool. Tonight you may want to try the exotic Carnivore restaurant and its many varieties of wild game before leaving Kenya. **B**

Day 15 NAIROBI-CAIRO. Transfer to the airport for your flight back to Cairo, where you will be transferred to your hotel. The afternoon is free or select from many optional tours. Later in the evening you will transfer to the Cairo Airport for your flight back to the USA. **B**

Day 16 CAIRO-USA. Arrive New York (JFK) airport.

EXTENSION: Mt. Kilimanjaro Trek 7 days/6 nights

Day 16 NAIROBI-ARUSHA-MT. KILIMANJARO. Fly from Nairobi back to Arusha, Tanzania and transfer to your mountain base accommodations at the Marangu Hotel. **D**

Day 17 MT. KILIMANJARO ASCENT. Depart after breakfast to the park gate at 6,000 feet where you begin the day's trek through plantations and forest to your first night's stop at 8,900 feet. **B,L,D**

DAY 18 MT. KILIMANJARO ASCENT. Walk a steep route through forest, grassland, heather and moors, with rest stops for spectacular views. Spend the night at the Horombo Hut Complex, 12,200 feet up the mountain. **B,L,D**

DAY 19 MT. KILIMANJARO ASCENT. Trek among unusual high altitude plant life to the barren terrain of "The Saddle" between Mawenzi and Kibo peaks, at 15,400 feet. **B,L,D**

DAY 20 MT. KILIMANJARO SUMMIT. Rise before sunrise to ascend before the cloud cover arrives on Gillman's Point, 18,640 feet above the earth. Hardy climbers can go on to the true summit, Uhuru Peak, at 19,340 feet, before beginning the descent. **B,L,D**

DAY 21 MT. KILIMANJARO DESCENT. Enjoy the easy descent to Marangu to receive your certificate. Then continue to your base hotel at the foot of Kilimanjaro. **B,L,D**

DAY 22 MT. KILIMANJARO ARUSHA-NAIROBI. After breakfast, you will depart for Arusha airport and the flight back to Nairobi. **B**

Zimbabwe Botswana Safari 14 days/13 nights

Day 1-2 DEPART JFK- HARARE. Arrive in Harare, modern capital city of Zimbabwe. An HLO representative will check you through formalities to your transfer for an overnight stay at the famous Imba Matombo Lodge.

Day 3 HARARE-KARIBA-KATETE LODGE. After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Kariba. From there you will be met by a representative from Katete Lodge and then continue on a light aircraft to the wilderness lodge. After check-in and lunch, enjoy an afternoon game drive by safari vehicle or boat. **B, L, D**

Day 4 KATETE LODGE. View countless wild animals and stunning scenery on a morning and afternoon game drive. **B, L, D**

Day 5 KATETE LODGE-KHATSHANA LODGE. After a morning game drive or boat excursion, check out for your charter flight back to Kariba, then board a plane for Hwange. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to the Khatshana Lodge. There you will check in and take an afternoon game drive. **B, L, D**

Day 6 KHATSI-IANA LODGE. Today you will experience thrilling morning and afternoon game drives in either open or closed safari vehicle. A wildlife expert is provided on all tours on this and every HLO African Wilderness Experience. **B, L, D**

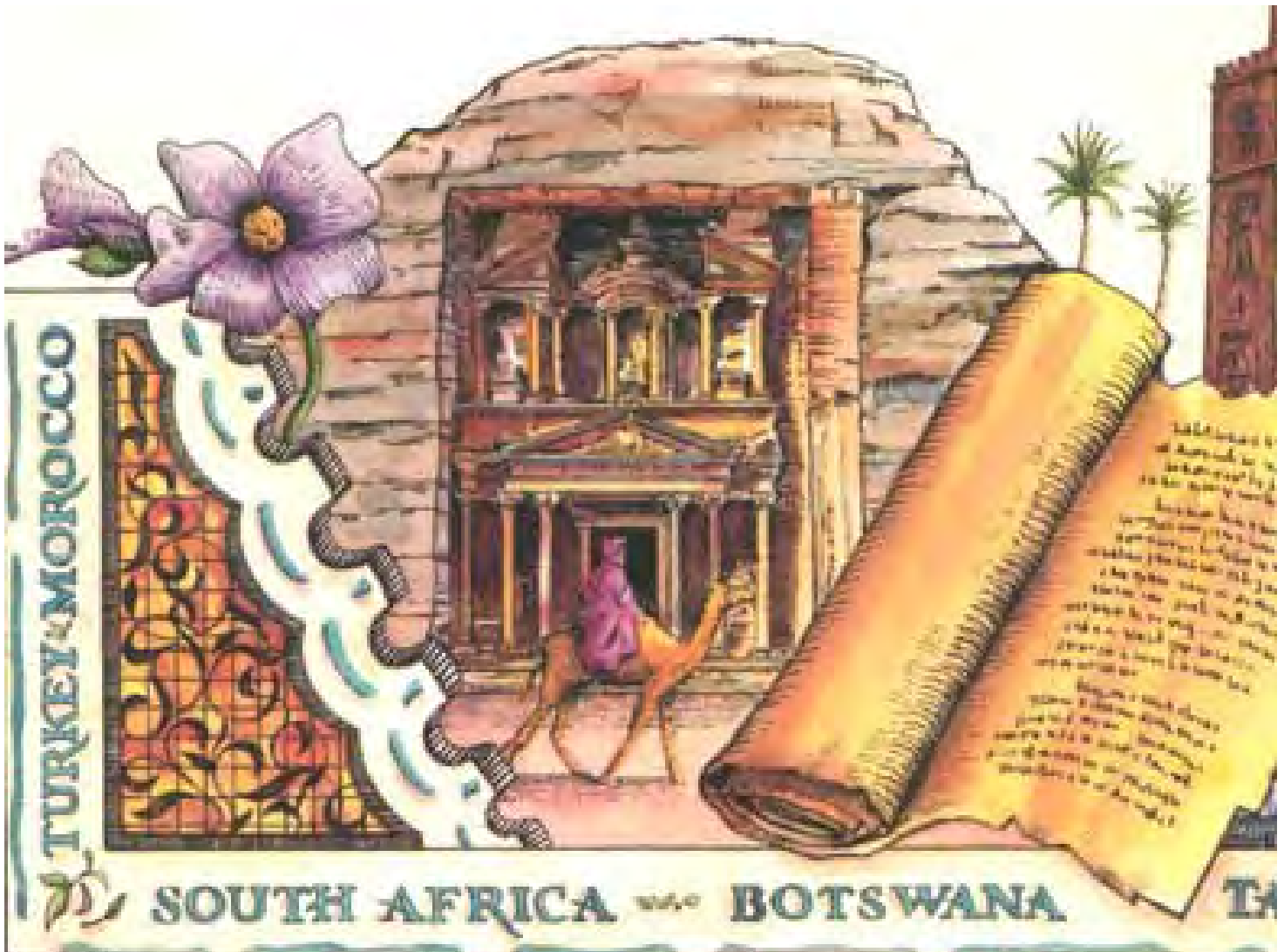
